### Posting Scores for Handicap Purposes

The USGA Course Rating System, used under licence by Golf Canada, provides Course Ratings and Slope Ratings only for 9-hole and 18-hole courses.

In order to permit the members of the Greenbryre Golf & Country Club to post their scores for the purpose of maintaining a Golf Canada Handicap Factor, two 18-hole equivalent courses have been set up on the Golf Canada Score Centre, named Greenbryre S-N-S and Greenbryre N-S-N.

#### **Members should enter their scores as illustrated in the following example:**

If the member plays 12 holes in the order the South 6 followed by the North 6 on Monday,

and another 12 holes in the same order on Tuesday,

then after the Tuesday round the member would post an 18-hole score into the Score Centre, selecting the Greenbryre S-N-S course. The score posted would consist of the 12 holes played on Monday along with the first 6 holes (the South 6) of Tuesday's round.

The member would keep the score from second 6 holes played on Tuesday (played on the North 6) until a third 12-hole round is played.

Once the third 12-hole round has been played, the member would post another 18-hole round, this time selecting the Greenbryre N-S-N course in the Score Centre. This score would consist of the North 6 from the Tuesday round along with the 12-hole score from the round just completed.

This process of combining three 12-hole scores into two 18-hole scores would then be repeated.

#### **A guest or visitor who maintains a Golf Canada Handicap Factor and plays an occasional 12-hole round at the Greenbryre Golf and Country Club should enter the score from his or her round as follows:**

If the round played is in the order of the South 6 followed by the North 6, the player enters a 9-hole score into the Score Centre, selecting the front 9 of the Greenbryre S-N-S course. The score entered must consist of the six holes from the South 6 plus the **first three** holes from the North 6. The scores from the remaining three holes are discarded.

If the round played is in the order of the North 6 followed by the South 6, the player enters a 9-hole score into the Score Centre, selecting the front 9 of the Greenbryre N-S-N course. The score entered must consist of the six holes from the North 6 plus the **first three** holes from the South 6. The scores from the remaining three holes are discarded.
